

MORVAL NEWS & EVENTS

I first wish to extend my sympathy to all involved in the recent tragic coach crash, not only the families of the bereaved, but also everyone else involved, including local residents, in what was a very traumatic time.

I would like to take this opportunity to clear up some misconceptions which appears to have arisen following some of the reporting of the incident. During one of the interviews I did state that the A387 speed review had not found a high accident rate on this stretch of road. Copies of this review are available if anyone would like to see them. I also said that there was no history of serious accidents and fatalities at this spot which is the case. This road is typical of many Cornish roads, in that it is steep in places and then narrows in other parts so that there is no white line. I, like many of you have driven this road many times, in a variety of vehicles, and know that it needs to be driven with care. I have persistently asked Highways to carry out improvements to this stretch of road, most recently during the recent St Martin's road diversion. This will be confirmed by Members of the Parish Council. I will continue to do so vigorously as I am aware that safety on this stretch of the road is a real concern to many of you.

Having said this it is important not to speculate on the cause of the accident – such speculation is not helpful to either the victims or their families, or indeed, to anyone else involved. We have to await the outcome of the police investigations.

Finally I would like to thank all the residents involved in supporting the victims. It was a very traumatic time. I have written to the Mayor of Exmouth to express my condolences, and similarly to Exmouth Age Concern, whilst thanking those volunteers for organising these excursions

The internal annual audit of the parish council's business has been completed with nothing untoward being raised. The external auditor will now carry out its examination and make any recommendations that it feels necessary. Once this is completed, the relevant documentation will be displayed on the notice board at Sandplace for people to see.

The first meeting of the newly formed Group is on the 2nd June 2014 at Nomansland Village Hall at 7pm.

A Neighbourhood Plan in its broadest form sets out local planning policies and allocates land for development. At the end of its journey having had to clear many hurdles the Final Plan is approved by the Parish Electorate via a referendum . It is then brought into legal force by the local planning authority and attains the same legal status as the Local Plan.

The steering group would be delighted if more residents of the Parish would join them, thereby ensuring a wide spectrum of views being represented. There will a great deal of support for members of the group to help with their decision making and a great deal of local consultation in order to make sure that the views of the Parish form the backbone of the Plan. The Group will endeavor to use all forms of communication both traditional, modern and innovative in order to reach all corners of the Parish , keep everybody up to date with progress and find out they would like to see in the Plan.

"I've lots of life in me yet, so why should I bother with Power of Attorney?"
