Hello Everybody

At its Annual Council Meeting held earlier this month, Councillor Clive Pearn was elected as Chair of the Council and Councillor Tracy Chudleigh as Vice-Chair.

Recent changes to the Regulations surrounding transparency require Parish Councils with an income of less than £25,000 to publish a substantial amount of information on a free to access for the public web site. As Morval Parish Council is a council affected by these changes, it has agreed to have its own web site professionally designed by a web site design team. This team has a vast amount of experience in designing web sites for Town and Parish Councils and is, therefore, able to provide a site that meets the Council's needs whilst allowing it to access the site as and when required. It is planned that the new web site should be available for the public to start accessing during June and once all is in place the web site address will be advertised on the notice boards around the parish.

The Parish Council has recently had its internal audit completed with nothing untoward to report. It will be submitting the relevant documentation to the external auditors within a few weeks and once returned, these documents and the external auditors report will be displayed on the notice board located at Sandplace.

At the AGM members vote for the member who deserves the Molly Bersey Trophy. This is the person who has contributed most to the WI in a non-official way.

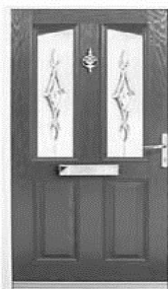
