The council is also pleased to be able to announce that the defaced road sign for Morview Road has now been replaced. It offers its thanks to the resident who initially brought the matter to its attention.

The council is aware that work continues on reducing the likelihood of flooding at Sandplace. Currently, to progress this matter, BT's copper experts need to move its wire from the old duct to a new duct. Once this is completed, measures required to reduce the likelihood of flooding can be continued.

The council is currently investigating the viability of having two bus shelters erected at Nomansland and the relocation of the bus stop for travelling towards Looe to a spot that may offer a reduction in risk when using it. Currently, and following a recent meeting between the relevant authorities and appropriate agencies a professional opinion on both matters is being sought from the Highways Department.
