Hello Everybody

Enquiries continue which will help the Parish Council reach a decision as to whether or not to proceed with the erection of two bus shelters at Nomansland.

The applications submitted by the Parish Council for the Reading Room and the "Village Green" at Widegates to be included on the Register of Community Assets have both been accepted by Cornwall Council. This means that if either was to be sold, the community and the Parish Council would have a period of time to look at ways it may purchase it before it went for sale on the open market. It is still waiting to hear whether or not Bindown Stores will be included on the Register.

The Parish Council has agreed to form a council led committee to consider the potential of a play area somewhere within the parish. If you have any interest in joining this committee, please contact me.

The first Parish Council meeting for 2016 was due to be held on Wednesday 6th January. The council has agreed, however, to change this meeting date so that it will now meet on January 13th 2016 for its first meeting of the year. Except where a meeting date falls on a Bank Holiday, the remaining meetings for 2016 will be held on the first Wednesday of each month except August when there is no meeting.


"Johnny! Please wait until we say our prayer," said his mother.
