PARISH NEWS

Hello Everybody

The Parish Council agreed on hearing the sad news of the death of Mr William Ough on the 22nd December 2015, that it would like to publicly recognise his commitment to the work of the council as a serving member. Mr Ough was a member for many years whilst his wife Pat was employed as the council's clerk for a similar amount of time. During this time, Mr Ough worked tirelessly to bring benefits to the parish as both a council member and as an individual member of the community. As a member of the Looe Lions, he participated in its charity work for the good of the area. As a younger man, Mr Ough was a member of the Morval football team and as an older gentleman he was always keen to share the vast knowledge that he had of parish life in previous years. The Parish Council would like to express its thanks for the great impact that Mr Ough made to parish life.

During its meeting held in January, the council was made aware by PCSO Cocks of a couple of men travelling around the parish in a white van and offering milk rounds to households. PCSO Cocks advised that anybody approached by these men should report it to the Police as soon as they are able. In addition, a second theft of some ducks has been reported and those with small livestock may wish to be vigilant and report any suspicious behaviour that they witness.

At the same meeting, Cornwall Councillor Candy reported that Cornwall Council is currently looking very carefully at how it is going to preserve its services delivered to vulnerable people and in order to achieve this, it may need to increase the council tax. The Parish Council agreed that it would increase its part of the council tax by 1.5% in preparation for any services devolved to it by Cornwall Council.

The Parish Council looks to resume and progress work that it is currently involved in now that the Xmas break is over.
