



Our thanks to everyone who took the time to complete the Morval NDP Questionnaire. We have received over 200 responses. These will now be analysed and passed to an independent consultant to draft our policies for the plan.

Following this, there will be a 6 week open public consultation, including events for you to come along and give feedback on the policies. This is likely to be during April/May. We will publicize the exact dates in Outlook, Morval website and the Facebook group.

- Cornwall Council Screening
- Public Consultation
- Cornwall Council Consultation
- Parish Referendum (If 'YES', Morval NDP is officially adopted)
