



Litter picking initiative by Morval Parish Council

Morval Parish Council intends to be at the vanguard of efforts to prevent litter ruining the countryside in the year ahead, and, at the instigation of councillor Stuart Hutchins, has acquired litter-picking equipment, now available for anyone, or organisation, in the parish who would like to arrange a 'Spring Clean' or something similar.

Councillors acted after reports of an increasing amount of rubbish that people are either dropping or throwing out of vehicle windows.

Councillor Hutchins hopes people in the Sandplace, Nomansland, Morval and Widegates communities would come forward to act as 'Litter Monitors' and take advantage of this equipment. He said: "If any volunteers want to work with us and help the Parish Council to keep our areas litter-free, then please contact the Clerk for full details. If we had one person in each area prepared to arrange a litter pick perhaps four times a year, it would be wonderful."
