#### **Key things in Morval Parish**

**Armand Toms** has been elected as County Councillor for the newly created ward of Looe East & Deviock.

**St Wenna's Church** is hoping to be able to open again for Sunday services on 27<sup>th</sup> June, but it all depends on when lockdown ends. The search for a new vicar continues, with a group meeting to draw together a statement of needs for a new benefice, where Looe and Morval will be joined by Duloe and Herodsfoot churches.

Morval Neighbourhood Development Plan is being scrutinised by the Parish Council. At the first meeting Paul Webber (the consultant who liaised with the Steering Group to produce the NDP) explained the format and answered questions. Pleasingly, the Development Officer at Cornwall Council has reviewed our NDP and said that it is 'well written, with clear and unambiguous policies' and the 'scale of the plan is right for a rural parish such as Morval'.
