The next task, which is well underway, is compiling and completing all the supporting documents needed, and then it will be submitted (hopefully by Christmas) to Cornwall Council for them to send it to the Independent Examiner, who will scrutinise it. When that is done, Cornwall Council will organise the Morval Parish NDP Referendum (which will include the possibility of postal voting, if required).
