

## Morval NDP is legally compliant!

We're getting near to the end of the NDP project! The Morval NDP (and the supporting documents), have been submitted to Cornwall Council, and our NDP has been assessed as legally compliant, meaning that doesn't contradict any restrictions with the Act of Parliament which applies to NDPs, and it is in harmony with the Cornwall Local Plan. After some additional consultation, the next stage is for approval by an Independent Assessor (who will check that all has been done correctly) and finally the Parish Referendum.
