

Morval Neighbourhood Development Plan update

The Morval Neighbourhood Development Plan Committee has been working hard to progress the project. This work has included a detailed examination of 27



NDPs that have already been adopted around Cornwall, to give an indication of the approaches and content that are likely to be approved by Cornwall Council. The Macmillan coffee morning at Widegates Village Hall on 28th September provided a valuable opportunity for members of the committee to gather more views from local residents. Given that there will be a certain amount of growth throughout Cornwall, **and that new developments within the parish are already being considered**, the questions on this occasion were focussed mainly on the type of housing development that people would like to see. Of those who took part in these conversations, most would like to see small housing developments, using traditional materials and of limited height, of a style in keeping with the surrounding properties. There was also a real enthusiasm for energy saving measures and environmental protection, for footpaths, green spaces and public transport, and provision for children to play safely. These findings were reported to Parish Council at the start of October. The next stage, as soon as Parish Council funding has been approved, is for every household to receive an information pack which will include the detailed questionnaire. Responses to this will form the basis of our own NDP policies, which will be able to influence the type of future development in the parish.
