

#### Hello Everyone

Announcement by Morval Parish Council - The Neighbourhood Plan The Parish Council, at its meeting in February received a report from the Neighbourhood Plan Group which it needed to consider.

After several months of working hard to progress a Plan, the findings of the Group can be summarised as follows:

 Confines of existing legislation could mean that a genuine local plan is very difficult to achieve e.g. the Neighbourhood Plan process allows a community to identify where development should take place but it doesn't allow a community to prevent development altogether.

- Much of Cornwall Council's new housing targets for the local community network have, it would appear, been claimed already by other surrounding parishes meaning that a likelihood of a large new development within the parish is not as high as feared.
- Current planning guidelines alongside a robust and fair deliberation of all planning applications by the Parish Council appear sufficient at this time to ensure that the parish is not over developed.
- Despite best efforts and for a variety of reasons, the Group had difficulty in engaging all sectors of the parish so that a broad spectrum of views, opinions and ideas were obtained meaning there was always a danger that any Plan compiled may not be a true representation of the population of the parish as a whole.
- Any further work needed to progress the Plan would need to be carried out by a fresh group of volunteers as the current group, having already completed a major part of the initial leg work required, wishes to stand down.

In addition to the findings of the Group, the council remains mindful of the huge amount of work required to compile a Plan and the potential cost to the parish that this could create.

With all things considered, the Parish Council has taken the decision not to progress the Plan but, if for any reason, the need for one becomes apparent in the future, the council would be able to re-visit its decision.

It would like to thank the members of the Neighbourhood Plan Group for the time and effort that each has given to this piece of work and the members of the parish who completed the questionaires produced by the Group.

#### MORVAL PARISH COUNCIL

## Invitation to tender for grass cutting and maintenance of the flowerbed at Widegates "Village Green" for the period May 1st 2015 to March 31st 2016.

The Parish Council invites tenders to cut the grass in the area outlined and shaded on the attached map. The grass would require cutting on a two weekly basis during the months of May through to September with additional cuts being carried out pre-events if required and twice during the months of October through to April if required and weather permitting. The grass cuttings would need to be disposed of by the person awarded the contract.

Maintenance of the flower bed would be carried out on a monthly basis from May through to September and twice during the months of October through to April if required and weather permitting so that the border remains weed free and the shrubs pruned and maintained as necessary.

An observational check of trees and shrubs for structure damage would be required at the start of the contract and six monthly thereafter with potentially harmful shrubs or plants being identified at the same time.

The person awarded the contract will need to have adequate public liability, and evidence of this should be provided with a tender letter of application which includes a brief method statement of how this work would be carried out in a safe manner.

Any person wishing to receive a copy of the map, the specification for the work required or those wishing to apply should contact the parish clerk who can provide a specification sheet and further details if required. Applications should be returned to the Clerk by the 31<sup>st</sup> March 2015.

#### "My family know what I want, so I needn't bother with a will"
