Initial analysis

- Replies represent 81 people. A few represented identical views of several people (greatest 5) so might have slightly skewed figures. Only 2 children identified but might have been more in family groups
- Mostly anonymous, but majority clearly from Widegates
- Quiet rural nature of parish hugely valued and felt to be under threat from new developments, particularly in Widegates
- General acceptance of the need for new houses, but should be limited in number, in keeping with the area and for needs of local people.
- Concern over development being specifically in Widegates and over lack of necessary infrastructure.
- Friendly locals, landscape value and attractiveness to tourists greatly valued and linked to small community feel
- Various concerns regarding increased traffic; speed, pollution, dangerous junctions, narrow lanes
- Several ask for footpaths (many specifically to farm shop), walking/exercise areas etc
- Several ask for safe children's play area
- Several highlight need for more central community focus eg social club, pub, community shop/post office etc.
- Need for greater community cohesion across parish- might be achieved through above.
